


# Schoolhouse Spotlights 2023

### TRANSPORTATION


#### **State vs. Local Pupil Transportation Expenditures**



The state share of total pupil transportation funding has decreased from approximately **50%** in the 1990s to about **12%** by FY 2023.

This funding shortfall contributes to a **shortage of bus drivers** which impacts Georgia students.

# Student Impact of Driver Shortage

- Lost Instruction Time Due to Late Arrivals
- Longer Bus Rides Home
- Increased Misbehavior on Buses

## ADDRESSING THE ISSUE

To address negative students impacts, Georgia should increase the state share of student transportation funding.
